CIRCULAR

I am directed to say that the units in Noida Special Economic Zone are already filing and the NSEZ Customs is disposing-off all the Shipping Bills and Bill of Entries electronically under the SEZ Online System and now no manual filing of these documents are allowed.

It is to remind you that the online transactions attract Rs 200/- transaction fee per Shipping Bill or Bill of Entry. The payment is being made online at the time of submission of the same from Unit Approver side. The complementary usage period is ending on 30th September, 2010 and all the transactions are being charged at the cited rates with effect from 01st October, 2010. The payment of transaction can be made online through Credit Cards / Net Banking or you may deposit advance amount as top-up in your admin user account after login at <https://www.sezonline-ndml.co.in/User/Login.aspx>.

You may make necessary arrangements to ensure that the filing of Shipping Bills/ Bill of Entry is not stopped in lack of payment of transaction fee.
