Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting in respect of 100% Export Oriented Units held under the chairmanship of Shri A. Bipin Menon, Zonal Development Commissioner, NSEZ at 11.00 AM on 27.02.2024 through Video Conferencing.

The following members of the Approval Committee were present during the meeting:-

- Shri Surender Malik, Joint Development Commissioner, NSEZ.
- 2. Shri Jagdish Chander, Assistant DGFT, Office of the Additional DGFT, Central Licensing Authority, New Delhi.

Besides, during the Approval Committee meeting i) Shri Rajesh Kumar, Deputy Development Commissioner, NSEZ, ii) Sh. H. K. Meena, Assistant Development Commissioner were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the quorum is available and the meeting can proceed.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After a brief introduction, the agenda was taken up sequentially. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants/units wherever required, the following decisions were taken:-

01. (2024) Ratification of the Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting held on 16.11.2023:-

It was informed to the Committee that no reference in respect of the decisions of the Approval Committee held on 16.11.2023 was received from any of the members of the Approval Committee or Trade. Hence the minutes of the meeting held on 16.11.2023 were unanimously ratified.

2 (2024) Application of M/s Gaur Metal Industries for setting up 100% EOU Unit registered office and factory address at E-299-300 Industrial Area Kuber (Extn.) Ranpur, Kota.

It was informed to the Committee that M/s Gaur Metal

Industries having registered and factory address at E-299-300 Industrial Area Kuber (Extn.) Ranpur Kota had applied for setting up 100%EOU for manufacturing and export of following items:-

- It was also informed to the Committee that antecedent verification report from Indore SEZ and VSEZ have been received and nothing adverse has been reported. Further, it was observed that the proposal of the unit was sent to jurisdictional Customs Authorities vide this office letter dated 20.11.2023 and subsequent reminder e-mail dated 02.02.2024 for site inspection and feasibility report. However, the same has not been received yet. The company has projected investment of Rs.8.60 Crores in Plant/Machinery/Capital goods and employment generation of 53 persons. Further Export projection of Rs. 224.11 Crores and NFE of Rs. 107.93 Cr. over the period of five years.
- 2.3 Mrs. Venus Maheshwari, CA and Sh. Devendra Kumar, Proprietor of the company attended the meeting. Sh. Kumar informed the Committee that he will import raw material from middle east countries and export to Asia, South Korea, Turkey, United State. He further informed the Committee that he had experience of more than 30 years of consultancy services in lead manufacturing industry located in South Africa, Nigeria, Dubai etc.
- 2.4 The Committee deliberated the proposal and unanimously decided to approve the it subject to receipt of site inspection and feasibility report from jurisdictional Customs Authorities. The Committee also directed to issue reminder to Customs for submission of site inspection and feasibility report and provide a copy of same to unit for further follow up.
- (3) 2024 M/s Plasti Weave Industries LLP for setting up a 100% EOU Unit registered office address at Plot No. A-450, Bhamashah Industrial Area Madri, Udaipur Rajasthan. and factory address E-180, F-183, Mewar Industrial Area Madri, Udaipur, Rajasthan -131021.

It was informed to the Committee that M/s Plasti Weave Industries LLP has applied for setting up 100%EOU at Plot No. A-450, Bhamashah Industrial Area Madri, Udaipur Rajasthan and factory address E-180, F-183, Mewar Industrial Area Madri, Udaipur, Rajasthan -131021 for manufacturing and export of following items:

- 3.2 It was also informed to the Committee that antecedent verification report from Indore SEZ and VSEZ have been received and nothing adverse has been reported. Further, it was observed that the proposal of the unit was sent to jurisdictional Customs Authorities vide this office letter dated 26.12.2023 and subsequent reminder e-mail dated 02.02.2024 for site inspection and feasibility report. However, the same had not been received yet. The company has projected investment of Rs. 16.90 Crores in Plant/Machinery/Capital goods and employment generation of 80 persons. Further Export projection of Rs. 139.65 Crores and NFE of Rs. 133.54 Cr. over the period of five years.
- 3.3 Sh. Sandeep Bapna, Partner of the company attended the meeting. Sh. Bapna informed the Committee that they have another 100% EOU unit i.e. M/s Harmony Plastic Pvt. Ltd. established in 2005. He further informed that they have already imported machinery which will be delivered within next two weeks and urged for issue of LOP at the earliest.
- 3.4 The Committee deliberated the proposal and unanimously decided to approve it subject to receipt of site inspection and feasibility report from jurisdictional Customs Authorities. The Committee also directed to issue reminder to Customs for submission of site inspection and feasibility report and provide a copy of same to unit for further follow up by them.

(4) 2024. Ratification of the permission granted for import/procurement and exporting the part of gift boxes to M/s M/s Vaibhav Global Limited.

It was informed to the Committee that M/s Vaibhav Global Limited is 100%EOU in Rajasthan and had been engaged in manufacture and export of Cut & polished precious/semi-

precious/synthetic stones/ diamonds, jewelry of gold / silver/ platinum/copper/bronze/ German silver, stainless steel, Gillette (Plain and studded with stones and diamonds). The Unit, vide its letter dated 28.12.2023 and email dated 06.02.2024, has submitted a request for import/procurement and exporting the following goods as part of gift boxes:-

4.2 The Approval Committee observed that para 6.32 (b) (viii) of HBoP 2023, empowers UAC to grant all approvals and clearances for establishment and operations of EOUs. In view of above, the permission for import/procurement and exporting the above goods as part of gift



boxes was conveyed to the unit vide this office letter dated 20.02.2024. The proposal was placed before UAC for ratification of the same.

4.3 The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, ratified the decision taken by the Development Commissioner on file subject to verification of Export policy of goods under Chapter 96 which is will be submitted on file.

(5) 2024 Application of Renewal of LOP for next five year M/s Rishabh Green Marbles Pvt. Ltd.

It has been informed that M/s Rishabh Green Marbles Pvt. Ltd. is a 100%EOU of Udaipur, having LOP No. 12222/2000-100%EOU-I dated 23.03.2000 for manufacture and export of Marble Slabs/ tiles and Marble Blocks.

- 5.2 As per record, unit's DCP is 31.03.2000 and last block was valid upto 31.03.2020. The Unit, vide letter dated 27.07.2020, applied for extension of validity of LOP which was extended upto 31.03.2021.
- 5.3 Unit has applied for extension of LOP, vide their letter dated 27.07.20220, 04.09.2020 17.06.2022, 12.07.2022, 22.10.2022. 12.04.2023 and e-mail dated 26.05.2023. but certain document/information were sought from the unit. Now, the unit vide its letter dated 24.01.2024 has submitted that they have never imported any inputs without payment of customs duty till date. Their main raw material was marble block which was not excisable till 30.06.2017 and thereafter there was no exemption of GST on procurement of marble blocks. Likewise, they had not availed any exemption of duty on other inputs till date. Neither they nor their supplier claimed any benefit of deemed export for the supplies of inputs procured from domestic market till date. The condition as regard to consumption of inputs by the EOU unit based on the SION is applicable only for the inputs on which the duty exemption has been claimed. In their case they neither claimed the duty exemption in the procurement of inputs nor claimed any benefits of deemed export for the supplies of inputs procured from domestic market hence there was no requirement for the SION fixation for the inputs used for their product.
- 5.4 Shri Poonam Chand Patel, Authorised representative has informed that they had not imported any inputs and they have done exports only from their EOU. The Committee noted that the unit has continued exporting despite lapse of validity of LOP in 2021.
- 5.5 The Committee deliberated on the proposal and directed to seek a report from jurisdictional Customs Authorities that how the unit had exported its goods despite lapse in the validity of LOP. The Committee also directed to seek a report from the unit on the export and import figures till date, mechanism of export when the LOP is not valid and
