

Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting in respect of private SEZs located in Noida, Greater Noida & Khurja held under the Chairmanship of Shri R.P. Goyal, Zonal Development Commissioner, NSEZ at 11:30 AM on 26.10.2020 through Video Conferencing.

It was informed that the quorum is available and the meeting can proceed.

❖ At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After brief introduction, each item included in the agenda was taken up for deliberations one by one. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the developers / units, wherever required, the following decisions were taken:-

**1. Ratification of the Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting held on 28.09.2020 :-**

As no reference in respect of the decisions of the Approval Committee held on 28.09.2020 was received from any of the members of the Approval Committee, Minutes of the Meeting held on 28.09.2020 were unanimously ratified.





**Item No.2: Proposals for expansion of area of the unit:-**

**2.1: Coforge Limited (Unit-IV) (erstwhile NIIT Technologies Ltd.)**

2.1.1. 2.1.2. Shri Rahul Sood, Sr. V.P. of Coforge Limited joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. 

5.1.7. Ms. Neha Garg, AVP-Finance & Procurement of Metlife Global Operations Support Centre Pvt. Ltd joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. She informed that the unit will not avail any tax exemption for creation & operation of aforesaid facilities.

5.1.7. After due deliberations, the Approval Committee unanimously approved the following proposals of Metlife Global Operations Support Centre Pvt. Ltd. (Unit-II):

relevant statutory authorities, wherever applicable, as required under Instruction No. 95 dated 11.06.2019. The Specified Officer will verify and ensure that statutory compliances and aforementioned conditions are being met.

- (ii) For sharing of aforesaid 'Cafeteria including Tuck Shop, Medical cum wellness room, Recreation Room & ATM' as well as 'Central Data Centre facility' with Metlife Global Operations Support Centre Pvt. Ltd. (Unit-I) located in the same SEZ, in terms of Rule 27(5) of the SEZ Rules, 2006, subject to the condition that the unit shall not be eligible for any tax exemption for creation & operation of aforesaid facilities. Segregation of authorized activities shall be maintained by both the units as per the provisions of SEZ Act, 2005 and rules made thereunder.

Segregation of authorized activities shall be maintained by both the units as per the provisions of SEZ Act, 2005 and rules made thereunder.



6.1.3. The Approval Committee observed that there is port restriction against the items proposed under HS Code 8703 (Sl. No. 24). Further, various items are 'Restricted' or having specific policy conditions.

6.1.4. Shri Roshan Lal, Sr. Manager-Regulatory of Arshiya 3PL Services Pvt. Ltd. joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. He informed that the unit will not be doing any business of "Restricted" items.

6.1.4. After due deliberations, the Approval Committee unanimously approved the proposal, subject to following terms & conditions:-

- (i). No export / import of any items will be allowed, which come under "Prohibited/Restricted" items/Negative list under Import policy given in ITC(HS) Classification or any other law and/or covered under SCOMET list as per DGFT Notifications / Public Notice / Instructions issued from time-to-time.
- (ii). Port restrictions as per DGFT Notifications / Public Notice / Instructions issued from time-to-time, shall be applicable.
- (iii). The scope of authorized operations of the unit will be strictly as per Rule 18(5) of SEZ Rules, 2006.
- (iv). Any sale in DTA shall be only in convertible foreign currency in terms of proviso to Rule 18(5) of SEZ Rules, 2006.
- (v). In case import or export of any item is Restricted by any conditions under FTP / Customs or any other rule / guidelines, such item should be imported / exported subject to such conditions.
