- 6.1.2. The unit has informed that they are mutually agreed with one foreign client namely M/s. Raytheon Company, Tucson, Arizona, USA for holding its imported and domestic procurements on Foreign Company's behalf at FTWZ as part of providing warehousing and value added services. M/s. Raytheon Company, on behalf of US Government, will supply Integrated Air Defence Weapons System via FTWZ to Indian Air Force / Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India. As per Project Report submitted by the unit, the proposed activities to be carried out in the FTWZ, are as under:
 - i. Post Shipment Verification (comprising of Inventory inspection, tracking, management and removal and replacement of faulty parts, if required).
 - ii. Quality audit and Post inspection check of goods.
 - iii. Pre-System Integration and Checkout (SICO) Checks viz. Functional tests to ensure that the equipment is in a workable condition.
 - iv. Storage of Spare parts (for use during Pre-SICO, SICO and/or training).
 - v. Packaging, Handling and Shipping.
 - vi. Training by Raytheon to IAF to enable Joint Receipt Inspection (JRI) activity
 - vii. Joint Receipt inspection by Raytheon and IAF.
- 6.1.3. The Approval Committee observed that the matter was deliberated by the Committee in the meeting held on 12.06.2020 and as per directions of the Committee the complete facts of the matter, was forwarded to DOC vide letter dated 09.07.2020 for information.
- 6.1.4. Shri Vikram Chhikaram, AVP of M/s. Arshiya joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. Besides, Shri Sanjeev Venkatesan, Director of M/s. Raytheon and Ms. Divya Bhushan, of E&Y also joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. The representatives informed that all three proposed items to be imported at the same time once the agreement is finalized. They further informed that no assembly activity of the proposed items to be carried out in

FTWZ. The representative of M/s. Arshiya informed that the additional security personnel shall be deployed and additional CCTV camera shall be installed in FTWZ to ensure proper security of the proposed items.

6.1.5. The Committee felt that since the proposed items were defence related and were to be supplied to Indian Air Force / Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India, the approval from Ministry of Defence and / or MHA may be required. Keeping in view of the sensitivity of the items, the Approval Committee unanimously directed to forward the proposal to DOC for seeking approval of the proposed activity, as DOC is a nodal agency in the case of applications for defence related equipment for SEZ units. The Committee also directed the representative of the unit to submit 8 Digit HS Code of the proposed items.On submission of these, the matter would be referred to DOC seeking their directions for granting approval.

- 2.1.2. Shri Harvinder Singh Panesar, Proprietor of M/s. Awat Logistics joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. He informed that their client's supplier M/s. Synthite has informed that they are using a solvent extract method to get the export product 'MITRAGYANA SPECIOSA EXTRACT (MS Extract)'. In explanatory notes to Chapter 33, it is mentioned that Chapter 33 does not cover natural oleoresin or vegetable extracts of heading 1301 or 1302. Natural oleoresins obtained out of different materials without solvent extraction covered under Chapter 13. All oleoresin and extracts obtained through solvent extraction process is specifically covered in Chapter 33.
- 2.1.3. After due deliberations, the Approval Committee unanimously <u>approved</u> the proposal inclusion of 'HS Code 33019090 (*MITRAGYANA SPECIOSA EXTRACT*)' in the LOA of the unit.
