

Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting in respect of private SEZs located in Noida, Greater Noida & Khurja held under the Chairmanship of Shri A. Bipin Menon, Development Commissioner, NSEZ at 12:00 PM on 08.04.2022 through Video Conferencing.

- Besides, during the meeting i) Shri Amit Gupta, Specified Officer, ii) Shri Prakash Chand Upadhyay, ADC, (iii) Shri Rajendra Mohan Kashyap, Steno Gr-II and (iv) Shri Anuj Dixit, UDC were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the quorum is available and the meeting can proceed.
- At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After brief introduction, each item included in the agenda was taken up for deliberations one by one. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the developers / units, wherever required, the following decisions were taken:-

1. Ratification of the Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting held on 03.03.2022 :-

2.2.2. After due deliberations, the Approval Committee unanimously approved the proposed list of materials, subject to the condition that Specified Officer shall ensure that no 'Restricted / Prohibited' item shall be allowed.

Item No. 3. Proposals for expansion / partial deletion of area of the unit :-

3.1. M/s. Globallogic India Pvt. Ltd. (Unit-II)

3.1.1. M/s GlobalLogic India Ltd. (Unit-II) has submitted proposal for partial deletion of '71939 Sqft. at 9th & 10th floor, Tower-3' from its total approved area of '218610 Sqft. at 5th to 10th floor, Tower-3 & 37366 Sqft. at 14th floor, Tower-3' of its unit located in the Oxygen Business Parks Pvt. Ltd. IT/ITES SEZ at Plot No. 7, Sector-144, Noida (Uttar Pradesh). The unit has submitted copy of 'NOC' issued by SEZ Developer for surrender of aforesaid area. The unit has informed that that there shall not be any changes in their projections given by them in Form-F1 for renewal of LOA beyond 30.05.2022.

3.1.2. Following observations have been found which have been communicated to the unit:-

- i. 'No Dues Certificate' from the Specified Officer required to be submitted in respect of area proposed to be deleted.
- ii. Value-wise details of input services of Rs.32342.31 lakhs giving Sl. No. & description as per default list of 67 services, required to be submitted.
- iii. As per APRs for the year 2017-18 to 2020-21 the unit had made sale of services of Rs.2535.34 lakhs. Hence, the unit needs to submit breakup details of such DTA sales viz (i) DTA sales against payment in foreign exchanges & ii). DTA sales against INR. Besides, as per NSDL data it is Rs.0.09 crore during aforesaid period. This also needs to be clarified.
- iv. In APRs for the year 2018-19 to 2020-21 the unit has shown deemed export [Supplies made under Rule 53A(a to k)] of Rs.2123.65 lakhs. Thus the unit needs to clarify the same that under which sub-rule of Rule 54A, the deemed exports have been made and what was the mode of payment received by the unit whether it is in INR or in foreign exchange. Besides, as per NSDL data the deemed export is Nil during aforesaid period. This also needs to be clarified.

3.1.3. Shri Sumit Malik, Director-Tax & Shri Anshul Anand Srivastava, Sr. Manager-Tax of M/s. Globallogic India Pvt. Ltd. joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. 


