

**NOIDA SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONE****Minutes of 7<sup>th</sup> meeting (2010 Series) of Unit Approval Committee for EOU Scheme held under the Chairmanship of Shri. S.C. Panda, Development Commissioner, NSEZ, Noida on 28.10.2010 at 11.30 AM at NSEZ, Noida.**

7<sup>th</sup> meeting (2010 Series) of Unit Approval Committee for EOU scheme (UAC) was held on 28.10.2010 under the Chairmanship of Shri S.C. Panda, Development Commissioner, Noida SEZ. List of participants is enclosed at Annexure I. The Chairman welcomed all participants of the UAC and thereafter agenda was taken up for discussion.

**7.1 Confirmation of minutes of 6<sup>th</sup> meeting (2010 series) of the UAC held on 30.08.2010**

The Committee ratified the minutes of the 6<sup>th</sup> UAC meeting (2010 Series).

**7.2 Proposal for setting up 100%EOU for manufacture & export of Artistic Steel/Brass/Wooden Furniture by M/s Airtech Pvt. Ltd, 50/A & 50/B, Site-IV, Sahibabad Industrial Area, Ghaziabad, U.P**

The Committee deliberated the proposal. No representative of the unit has attended the meeting. It is brought to the notice of the Committee that two LOPs have been issued earlier to this company, which they have not executed. The present proposal for setting up 100%EOU unit is for one of the premises for which LOP was issued in 2004. Unit was requested to submit ground and lay out plan of the proposed location but they have not. It is also noted that the company has not complied with the deficiencies communicated to them.

C.Ex. Officers from the Jurisdictional Commissionarate have also informed that the unit has not complied with to their correspondences. They further informed that they have requested the company telephonically to submit certain documents and details for verification of their proposals which have also gone in vain.

In view of the foregoing, the Committee viewed that the applicant is not serious for the proposal and in fact they have not divulged fact that they are in operation in DTA whereas they have submitted the application for setting up a new 100%EOU.

Accordingly, the Committee rejected the proposal.

**7.3 Proposal for conversion of DTA unit into 100%EOU for manufacture & export of bulk drugs by M/s. MAHIMA Life Sciences Pvt. Ltd, B.S.T. Road, Ganaur, Distt., Sonapat, Haryana**

The Committee deliberated the proposal and noticed that this company was under EOU Scheme till 17.06.2010 and debonded after fulfilling all obligations. The representative of the unit submitted before the Committee that they have opted to operate again under EOU for effective inventory management for expeditious exports which is lagging presently due to time lag in obtaining the advance licenses and procurement of the raw material thereafter.

The Jurisdictional C.Ex officers have submitted a report stating that the track record of the company is satisfactory and there is no case against the unit.

In view of the foregoing and taking note of good financial condition of the company and unblemished track record of the company, the Committee decided to approve the proposal.

**7.4 Ratification of permission for domestic procurement of three DG Set, two Transformers of 1500 KVA each and revision of import entitlement of capital goods by M/s UOP India Pvt. Ltd. DLF City, Gurgaon, Haryana**

The Committee deliberated the proposal. The representative of the unit presented their case that they are wholly owned subsidiary of UOP LLC, USA and setting up pilot plants of refinery for technological development which require uninterrupted power supply. They have mentioned that they are requiring three DG Sets of 1500 KVA each for optimum use of the power depending upon the load factor requirement. The total capacity of three DG set is not exceeding the maximum power load sanction by the Electricity Board to them.

In view of the foregoing and taking into view the indispensable requirement of the power load for simulation of refining product & process in the pilot plants being set up by the unit, the Committee decided to ratify the approval for domestic procurement of three DG Sets of 1500 KVA each and two Transformers of 1500 KVA each. The Committee also ratified the revision of import entitlements.

**7.5 Broad-banding for goods viz. Tactical Vest, Rucksack, Jacket Combat Grill Disruptive, Field Jacket, Combat Vest, Quilted Pad in Nylon Pouch, Jacket Combat Disruptive, High Temperature Industrial Safety Helmet and Insulated Tiles by M/s Indian Armour Systems Pvt Ltd., Universal Lane, Village Dudhoia, Palwal-121102, Haryana**

The Committee deliberated the proposal. The representative of the unit has made a detailed presentation for broad-banding of the goods. The Committee noted that the Ministry of Defence, Dept. of Defence Production vide their letter 15.09.2010 has summarized list of the goods which do not require 'no-objection' from them. The representative of the unit stated that the goods which are not covered under the aforesaid letter are being pursued with the respective department of Defence Production for issuing NOC. The unit's representative has further stated that during the process of obtaining the NOC for enabling export of Defence related items, they have developed certain other goods (High temperature industrial safety helmet and insulated tiles) by using the same infrastructure and plant & machinery and requested to allow broad-banding of these items also in their LOP.

After a detailed deliberation on the proposal and process of manufacture, the Committee decided to approve:

- i) broad-banding of items as per their application which do not require NOC from Ministry of Defence;

- ii) broad-banding of items which requires NOC from the Ministry of Defence shall be approved on file only after production of NOC from the concerned department; and
- iii) broad-banding of other goods (High Temperature industrial safety helmet and insulated tiles) which are to be manufactured with the installed plant and machinery for export as non-defence product.

**7.6 Broad-banding for goods viz Uniform, Clothing, Jacket Combat Disruptive and Jacket Harness, Vests. For these items, NOC from M/o Defence is not required. In addition, the unit proposes to manufacture Ceramic Beams and Structures (Rods, Pipes, Kiln Furniture), Vacuum Chucks, Ceramic Shields, using the same infrastructure, plant & machinery and the same process by M/s S.M. Caraspace Armor, Palwal, Distt-Faridabad, Harayana**

The Committee deliberated the proposal. The representative of the unit has made a detailed presentation for broad-banding of the goods. The Committee noted that the Ministry of Defence, Dept. of Defence Production vide their letter 15.09.2010 has summarized list of the goods which do not require 'no-objection' from them. The representative of the unit stated that the goods which are not covered under the aforesaid letter are being pursued with the respective department of Defence Production for issuing NOC. The unit's representative has further stated that during the process of obtaining the NOC for enabling export of Defence related items, they have developed certain other goods [Ceramic Beams and Structures (Rods, Pipes, Kiln Furniture), Vacuum Chucks, Ceramic Shields] by using the same infrastructure and plant & machinery and requested to allow broad-banding of these items also in their LOP.

After a detailed deliberation on the proposal and process of manufacture, the Committee decided to approve:

- i) broad-banding of items as per their application which do not require NOC from Ministry of Defence;
- ii) broad-banding of items which requires NOC from the Ministry of Defence shall be approved on file only after production of NOC from the concerned department; and
- iii) broad-banding of other goods [Ceramic Beams and Structures (Rods, Pipes, Kiln Furniture), Vacuum Chucks, Ceramic Shields] which are to be manufactured with the installed plant and machinery for export as non-defence product.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the chair.
