Minutes of Ist Meeting (2010 Series) of Unit Approval Committee for EOU Scheme held under the Chairmanship of Shri. S.C. Panda, Development Commissioner, NSEZ, Noida on 14.01.2010 at 11:45 AM at NSEZ, Noida.

1st Meeting (2010 Series) of Unit Approval Committee for EOU scheme was held on 14.01.2010 under the Chairmanship of Shri S.C. Panda, Development Commissioner, Noida SEZ. List of participants is enclosed at Annexure I. The Chairman welcomed all the participants of the UAC and thereafter agenda was taken up for discussion.

1. Confirmation of minutes of 5th meeting (2009 series) of the UAC held on 7.12.2009.

The Committee ratified the minutes of the 5th UAC meeting (2009 series).

2. Proposal of M/s Therachem Research Medilab (I) Pvt. Ltd. for conversion of DTA unit into 100% EOU at E-969-969A, Bio-Tech Park, RIICO Ind. Area, Sitapura, Jaipur – 302022 for research and process development

The Committee noticed that unit has not submitted document to substantiate their financial position for funding of the proposed project as was requested in the last UAC meeting held on 07.12.2009. The Committee further noticed that the Jurisdictional Commissioner of Central Excise has not supported the proposal. The unit has neither submitted any explanation in respect of funding for the project nor attended the meeting. Hence, the Committee decided to reject the proposal.

3. Proposal of M/s Sun Pharmaceutical Industries for partial conversion of existing DTA unit into 100% EOU at 6 to 9, EPIP, Kartholi, Bari Brahmana, Jammu–(J & K) for manufacture & export of Pharmaceuticals formulations.

The Committee deliberated proposal of the unit. The Committee noticed that the Jurisdictional Commissioner of Customs & Central Excise (J&K) has reported that physical segregation of two units (DTA unit & proposed EOU unit) is not possible in view of the common usage of entry & exit as well as few common facilities. The committee heard the unit's representatives. The unit's representatives have explained that it is possible to segregate DTA & EOU unit distinctly as they have done the same in their other units under jurisdiction of other Development Commissioners. The line of manufacture of both units would be separate as proposed EOU would be concentrating mostly on export's order to particular countries.

Keeping in view that Commissioner of Cus & C.Ex has proposed re-examination of the legal provisions & feasibility for complete demarcation of the two units through the Divisional Dy. Commissioner of Central Excise, the Committee deferred the proposal.

4. **Proposal of M/s UOP India Private Ltd. for setting up 100% EOU at 9/7/2 P, 81/P, 12,13,14/1/17/2,18,19,22,23, 12/2/3, Vill. Mohammedpur, Jharsa, Sector-36, Pace City-II, Gurgaon.**

The Committee heard the representatives of the unit. They have explained that theirs' company is existing and working in DTA and the present proposal is for Unit-II of the same company. The unit's representatives stated that their existing company has incurred loss in the financial year 2008-09 and the company's net worth has been eroded. However, the company is now doing well and they would have a fresh FDI for the proposed EOU. In respect of the services to be rendered by the proposed EOU, the unit's representatives have submitted a presentation in hard copy in order to explain that they would be undertaking research and development activity for the petro-chemical sector.

The Committee approved the proposal subject to submission of their financial statement for the current year (upto September 2009) duly certified by Chartered Accountant.

5. **Proposal of M/s Albion Consulting Pvt. Ltd for conversion of DTA unit into 100%EOU at F-90/12, Okhla Industrial Area, Phase-I, New Delhi for manufacture & export of Gold, Diamond & Silver Jewellery (Handmade).**

The Committee heard the unit's representative who has explained their marketing tie-up in respect of the export of handmade jewellery and decided to approve the proposal.

6. **Proposal of M/s Radical Overseas Pvt. Ltd. for setting up of 100%EOU at Bagadpur Siyana Road, Garh Mukteshwar, Distt. Ghaziabad for manufacture & export of Basmati Rice, discoloured Grian, Waste, Husk, Bran, Broken Rice.**

The Committee requested the representatives of the unit to explain the source of finance for their proposed project as the project report submitted by them does not reveal adequate funding to support their project. The unit's representatives submitted that they have obtained a term loan from the SBI and their authorized share capital has been increased sufficiently. However, these information were not submitted earlier.

In view of unit's submission, the Committee approved the proposal.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the chair.
