Minutes of meeting of Unit Approval Committee of Mahindra World City (Jaipur) Ltd. (Light Engineering Industry & Handicraft Sector) held on 20.09.2010 at 12.30 PM at Conference Hall, NSEZ, Noida

The meeting was chaired by Shri S.C. Panda, Development Commissioner. Besides, Jt. Development Commissioner. DC(Customs), ADC (RK) and the following members of UAC & representatives of SEZ Developer attended the meeting:-

2. Shri J.L. Basumatary, Commissioner, Income Tax, Jaipur
3. Shri A.K. Gupta, G.M, RIICO, Jaipur
4. Shri V.K. Mishra, Manager, Mahindra World City (Jaipur) Ltd.

At the outset Development Commissioner welcomed the Officers and representatives of SEZ developer & SEZ Units.

Following issues was discussed in the meeting: -

1. Review of the progress of the development of SEZ.

The Quarterly report for the period ending 30th June, 2010 submitted by the developer in Form-E, in respect of both SEZs was placed before the UAC & the same has been taken note of by UAC.

The representative of M/s. Mahindra World City (Jaipur) Ltd. informed that the connecting road has been completed from the both side and black top has been done. Construction of 7 KM internal roads has been completed. 14 KMs Strom water drains work has been completed. Construction of temporary Customs Building has been completed and become operational. Water supply work and sewerage plant work has been completed in both SEZs.

2. Extension of time limit for temporary removal of duty free goods for job work / Sub-contracting in DTA.

The proposal of the developer for extension for another 06 months in the time limit for temporary removal of duty free goods for job work / sub-contracting in DTA approved vide letter no. 10/192/2008-SEZ/3197 dated 14.05.2009 & letter no. 10/191/2008-SEZ/3199 dated 14.05.2009, was discussed by the approval committee. UAC decided to grant another extension for 06 months beyond 30.09.2010 for the use of balance material.

3. Proposal of M/s. Rama Handicrafts Ltd. for setting up a SEZ unit at Mahindra World City (Handicraft Sector) SEZ.

The proposal of M/s. Rama Handicrafts Ltd. for grant of LOA for setting up unit in Mahindra World City (Handicraft Sector) SEZ for manufacture & export of “Readymade garment and made ups and PVC bags and other handicrafts” was placed before the approval committee. After detailed discussions, UAC rejected the proposal as the proposed item of manufacture are not predominantly made by hand and does not fall under the category of Handicraft sector.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
