OFFICE ORDER

Subject: Serious delay in placing the case of M/s East Elm before UAC, Moradabad SEZ – accountability and monitoring of pending cases – reg.

Vide decision dated 10.02.2025, the Approval Committee (UAC), Moradabad SEZ, had directed that the case of M/s East Elm be decided on file after obtaining the Legal Opinion and had empowered the Development Commissioner, NSEZ, to take a decision thereon. The Legal Opinion was received on 10.06.2025. However, the case was not placed before the Approval Committee thereafter and came up for consideration only in the Moradabad UAC meeting held on 10.09.2026, after a gap of more than fifteen (15) months.

2. A similar instance of serious lapse and prolonged delay, including failure to submit replies at various stages, has also been noticed in the case relating to a GST notice issued in December 2023, which ultimately resulted in confirmation of the demand.

3. The following directions are accordingly issued:

- (i) All ADCs and dealing hands shall closely monitor cases pending for decision/action before the Approval Committee or this office, particularly those awaiting Legal Opinion or a response from other departments. Such cases shall be placed for consideration/action immediately upon receipt of the requisite input.
- (ii) All ADCs are directed to submit, within seven (7) days, a report of all cases that have remained pending at their respective levels for a considerable period (it shall include all receipts/cases that have remained pending for more than ten (10) days from the date of receipt). Further, ADCs shall also furnish a certificate certifying that no cases, other than those specifically mentioned in their report, are pending with them. Any misreporting or suppression of pending cases shall be viewed seriously and may attract appropriate action.
- (iii) All concerned are further directed to act promptly and expeditiously in all matters so as to ensure zero pendency.
