Minutes of the Unit Approval Committee meeting in respect of EOUs located under the jurisdiction of Zonal Development Commissioner, NSEZ, held under the Chairmanship of Shri Gopal Meena, Zonal Development Commissioner, NSEZ at 12:00 Noon on 23.07.2026.

A. The following members of Approval Committee were present during the meeting:-

1. Shri Paras Mani Tripathi, Joint Development Commissioner, NSEZ
2. Shri Nitin Chand Negi, Additional Commissioner of Customs, Ludhiana.
3. Smt. Aashima Chawla, Dy. DGFT, Office of the Additional DGFT, Central Licensing Authority, New Delhi.
4. Shri Ajay Gupta, Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Ludhiana.

B. Besides, during the meeting (i) Shri Aashish Madanlal Rawlani, DDC; and (ii) Shri Sushil Kumar, ADC were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the quorum was available and the meeting could proceed.

C. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After brief introduction, the agenda was taken up sequentially. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Unit Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the units/applicants, the following decisions were taken unanimously: -

D. New initiatives / reforms in view of good governance for Viksit Bharat 2047 were taken:-

- Calendar for conducting the Unit Approval Committee meeting has been issued.
- Only those proposals which are received before five working days of the next scheduled date of the Unit Approval Committee, shall be placed before the Unit Approval Committee.
- In case of new EOU application, following parameters may be considered:
- The proposal should be sent immediately to Jurisdictional Customs and Other SEZs for site inspection/ antecedent verification at the level of ADC.
- Master checklist in terms of Annexure-6A including required details viz. Marketing Tie-ups, ITRs and KYC documents of promoters, minimum investment criteria duly supported with list of machinery & a chartered engineer's certificate along with any other necessary additional details should be prepared and also published on website for better resolution.
- The cases in which the Unit Approval Committee has communicated the observations to the representative of the unit and the matter has been deferred due to that, in those cases the unit is required to comply with the observations within 5 working days (from the date of issue of the minutes) failing which the proposal may be treated as withdrawn.
- Officers/ Staff will issue all LOPs immediately and email to concerned units.

H. Item wise decisions on proposals included in agenda:

1. Ratification of the Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting held on 03.06.2026:-

It was informed that there were neither any references nor objections against the decisions of the Unit Approval Committee held on 03.06.2026. Hence, the Minutes of the Unit Approval Committee meeting dated 03.06.2026 were unanimously ratified by the Unit Approval Committee.

Item No. 2: Setting up a new 100% EOU:

2.1: Application of M/s Quarkcity Medtech Private Limited for setting up a new 100%EOU unit at at 'Plot No. 61, Vividha Industrial Estate, Village Chamaru, Tehsil Rajpura, Patiala, Punjab - 140401'

2.1.1 It was informed to the Approval Committee that M/s. Quarkcity Medtech Pvt. Ltd. has submitted a **proposal for setting up a new 100%EOU** at 'Plot No. 61, Vividha Industrial Estate, Village Chamaru, Tehsil Rajpura, Patiala, Punjab - 140401' for manufacture and export of "Medical Equipments viz. (i) MRIdian (Electro-diagnostic apparatus used in medical/ surgical sciences) (90181300)(10 Nos/annum); (ii) Naked Linac System (Apparatus based on the use of X-rays for medical/ surgical uses)(90222100)(10 Nos/annum); (iii) CT-guided MRI Machine (electro- diagnostic apparatus used in medical/ surgical sciences) (90181300)(10 Nos/annum); (iv) Photom CT Linac Machine (Apparatus based on the use of X-rays for Medical/ surgical uses) (90222100)(10 Nos/annum)". The applicant has proposed export of Rs.86719.00 lakh and cumulative NFE of Rs.45996.00 lakh over a period of five years. The cumulative projected investment in Plant & Machinery has been proposed as Rs. 10400.00 Lakhs.

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2.1.2 Shri Rajesh Sharma, Vice President of M/s. Quarkcity Medtech Pvt. Ltd. appeared before the Approval Committee through video conferencing and explained the proposal in detail.

2.1.3 It was further informed that Jurisdictional Customs in its site inspection report has inter alia stated as under:

"6. References have been made to DRI and DGGI for antecedent verification of the applicant and its directors. The reports are awaited.

*7. In view of the foregoing, **this interim report is being forwarded wherein premises verification has been done and found to be suitable.** During the physical verification, it was observed that the premises are adequately secured with a dedicated CCTV surveillance system and deployment of security personnel. Separate entry and exit points have been provided, and appropriate security arrangements are in place to ensure effective access control, monitoring of movement of goods and personnel, and safeguarding of the proposed EOU operations. The infrastructure and security measures available at the premises are considered adequate for carrying out the proposed manufacturing and export activities under the EOU Scheme. **However since the antecedent verification report of the applicant and its Directors are yet to be received, recommendations for setting up of the EOU are kept on hold.**"*

2.1.4 Shri Sharma, company representative informed the Committee that no cases pertaining to DRI, Customs, DGGI, SEZ authorities, or any other Government agency are pending against the company or its Directors.

2.1.5 The Committee directed the applicant to submit an affidavit to the effect that no cases pertaining to DRI, Customs, DGGI, SEZ authorities, or any other Government agency are pending against the company or its Directors. The Committee further noted that, in terms of Para 6.01 and Para 6.02 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP), 2023, Export Oriented Units (EOUs) are established with the objective of promoting exports and earning positive Net Foreign Exchange (NFE). Accordingly, in order to facilitate export promotion and considering the positive recommendations received in the site inspection report of the Jurisdictional Customs authorities as well as other Zonal DCs, the Committee was of the view that the Letter of Permission (LOP) may be issued to the applicant, subject to submission of the aforesaid undertaking and with the condition that in the event of any adverse report is received subsequently from any Government department or agency, appropriate action, including suspension or cancellation of the Letter of Permission, may be initiated.

2.1.6 The Jurisdictional Customs authorities conveyed their concurrence and stated that they would submit the antecedent verification report at the earliest.

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2.1.7 The Unit Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, **unanimously decided to approve** the proposal of M/s. Quarkcity Medtech Private Limited for **setting up a new 100%EOU** at 'Plot No. 61, Vividha Industrial Estate, Village Chamaru, Tehsil Rajpura, Patiala, Punjab - 140401' for manufacture and export of "Medical Equipments viz. (i) MRIdian (Electro-diagnostic apparatus used in medical/ surgical sciences) (90181300)(10 Nos/annum); (ii) Naked Linac System (Apparatus based on the use of X-rays for medical/ surgical uses)(90222100)(10 Nos/annum); (iii) CT-guided MRI Machine (electro- diagnostic apparatus used in medical/ surgical sciences) (90181300)(10 Nos/annum); (iv) Phatom CT Linac Machine (Apparatus based on the use of X-rays for Medical/ surgical uses) (90222100)(10 Nos/annum)". However, the Letter of Permission (LOP) shall be issued only after receipt of the above-mentioned affidavit from the applicant. The final verification report, upon receipt from Customs, shall be placed before the next meeting of the Unit Approval Committee for information and ratification. In the event any adverse report or material information is received subsequently from any Government department or agency, appropriate action, including suspension or cancellation of the Letter of Permission, may be initiated in accordance with the provisions of the Foreign Trade Policy, Handbook of Procedures, and other applicable laws and regulations.

Item no. 3: Conversion of existing DTA unit into 100%EOU

3.1 M/s Panicle Worldwide Private Limited for conversion of existing DTA unit into 100%EOU unit at 'Plot No. 18-B, Indra Complex, Baselwa Village, Faridabad, Haryana – 121002'.

3.1.1 It was informed to the Approval Committee that M/s. Panicle Worldwide Private Limited has submitted a proposal for conversion of their existing DTA unit at 'Plot No. 18-B, Indra Complex, Baselwa Village, Faridabad, Haryana – 121002' to 100%EOU for manufacture and export of "Instant Coffee (Flavoured/Non-flavoured) (ITC HS Code: 21011120, 21011110) (Capacity: 330000 Nos/month)". The applicant had proposed export of Rs.29869.00 lakh and cumulative NFE of Rs.29582.00 lakh over a period of five years. The cumulative projected investment in Plant & Machinery has been proposed as Rs. 120.00 Lakhs.

3.1.2 It was informed that, as per the site inspection report received from the Jurisdictional Customs authorities, **no plant and machinery related to the manufacture of coffee was found at the proposed premises.** Further, as per the manufacturing process flow chart submitted by the applicant, the proposed activities comprise packing/bottling, sealing & capping, labelling, storage and dispatch.

3.1.3 It was further informed that a meeting was held at DC Office, wherein the applicant submitted that it proposes to procure non-flavoured coffee, add different flavours thereto, and thereafter export the finished product. It was observed that the aforesaid activity would constitute "manufacture" in terms of Para 11.31 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP), 2023, as against the activities of packing/bottling, sealing and capping, labelling, storage, and dispatch initially proposed by the applicant.

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3.1.4 Further, as per the application submitted in ANF-6A, conversion of the existing DTA unit into a 100% EOU has been sought for the full existing capacity of the unit. However, the project report submitted by the applicant and the site inspection report of the Jurisdictional Customs authorities indicate that no plant and machinery related to the manufacture of coffee is presently available at the premises and that the applicant proposes to procure new machinery exclusively for the proposed project. Accordingly, **it appears that the instant proposal is in the nature of setting up of a new EOU rather than conversion of an existing DTA unit into a 100% EOU under Para 6.18 of the FTP, 2023.**

3.1.5 It was further informed that subsequently the applicant **vide its email dated 22.07.2026 has withdrawn their application** and stated that they shall submit a fresh application for the setting up of a new EOU instead of seeking conversion of the existing DTA unit.

3.1.6 The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, unanimously decided to **accept the withdrawal request** of the applicant. The Committee also decided to afford the applicant an opportunity to submit a fresh and complete proposal for setting up a new 100% EOU.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
