### **Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting in respect of SEZs located in Noida, Greater Noida & Khurja (Uttar Pradesh), held under the Chairmanship of Shri A. Bipin Menon, Development Commissioner, NSEZ at 11.30 AM on 02.01.2025.**

- Besides, during the meeting (i). Shri Gya Prasad, DDC, (ii). Shri Kiran Mohan Mohadikar, Specified Officer(I/C), (iii). Shri Prakash Chand Upadhyay, ADC & (iv) Shri Anuj Dixit, UDC /Dealing hand, were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the quorum was available and the meeting could proceed.
  - At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After a brief introduction, the agenda was taken up sequentially. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the developers / units, the following decisions were taken unanimously:-

#### **1. Ratification of the Minutes of the Approval Committee meeting held on 05.12.2024:-**

As no reference in respect of the decisions of the Approval Committee held on 05.12.2024 was received from any of the members of the Approval Committee or trade, the Minutes of the Meeting held on 05.12.2024 were ratified.

#### **Item No. 2. Proposal for approval of list of materials:**

##### **2.1: M/s. Wipro Limited, Developer**

2.1.1. Shri Raj Kumar Singh, Senior Manager & Shri Narotam Kumar Sharma, authorized representative of M/s. Wipro Limited joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the requirement of proposed materials.

2.1.2. The Approval Committee discussed the proposal in detail and after due deliberations approved the remaining list of materials proposed by M/s. Wipro Limited, Developer to carry on following authorized operations in its IT/ITES SEZ at Plot No. 2,3 & 4, Sector-Knowledge Park IV, Greater Noida (Uttar Pradesh):-

2.1.3. This approval is subject to the condition that the Specified Officer shall ensure that procurement of products 'Restricted / Prohibited' for import shall not be allowed.

**Item No. 3. Proposal for addition of Incubation space in the unit:**

**3.1. M/s. Teleperformance Global Business Private Limited.**

3.1.1. Shri Santosh Gaikwad, Senior Manager of M/s. Teleperformance Global Business Private Limited joined the meeting through video conferencing and explained the proposal. He informed that due to business exigency and requirement of overseas client to render the services with immediate effect, they wanted to commence operations from the proposed Incubation area, till the availability of permanent space. It was informed to the Committee that the unit had submitted a provisional offer of space of SEZ Developer for allotment of fitted-out incubation space.

3.1.2. The Approval Committee discussed the proposal in detail and after due deliberations approved the proposal of M/s. Teleperformance Global Business Private Limited for addition of Incubation space i.e. '*total 91179 Square feet area comprising of 31053 Square feet at 9<sup>th</sup> floor, Tower-9, 34953 Square feet at 12<sup>th</sup> floor, Tower-9 & 25173 Square feet at 6<sup>th</sup> floor, Tower-10*'. This is in respect of its unit located in the Seaview Developers Private Limited IT/ITES SEZ at Plot No. 20 & 21, Sector-135, Noida (Uttar Pradesh).

**Item No. 4. Proposal for inclusion of additional items in LOA of the FTWZ unit:-**

**4.1. M/s. Margo Impex Private Limited.**

4.1.1. As per directions given by the Approval Committee in its meeting held on 05.12.2024, M/s. Margo Impex Private Limited had submitted following 8 digit HS Codes of the products to be added in LOA:-

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4.1.2. Shri Sumit Wadhva, Authorised Representative of M/s. Margo Impex Private Limited appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal.

4.1.3. The Approval Committee discussed the proposal in detail in light of the nature of business and Guidelines for Operational Framework of FTWZ & Warehousing units in SEZ issued vide Instruction No. 117 dated 24.09.2024. After due deliberations, the Committee approved the proposal for inclusion of aforesaid products / HS Codes in the LOA of M/s. Margo Impex Private Limited.

**Item No. 5. Request for reconsideration of HS Codes removed from the LOA of the FTWZ Unit:-**

**5.1. M/s. Margo Impex Private Limited-**

5.1.1. Shri Sumit Wadhva, Authorised Representative of M/s. Margo Impex Private Limited appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. He requested to the Approval Committee for reconsideration of the products under HS Code 0801 & 0802.

5.1.2. The Approval Committee discussed the proposal in detail in light of the sensitivity of business plan and Guidelines for Operational Framework of FTWZ & Warehousing units in SEZ issued vide Instruction No. 117 dated 24.09.2024. It was noted that Instruction 117 had specifically come in the light of the adverse reports and inputs received related to functioning of some warehousing units. The Committee maintained its position that on account of the sensitivity given the investigations and seizure by agencies, quality of consignments including the risk of diversion due to the long inland transport, absence of economic rationale after incurring such high freight costs, difficulties in valuation due to volatility of prices, possibility of trading in precious metals, referencing some of the high risk commodities which are part of their LOA in Instruction 117, cases of transfer from other FTWZs prior to this Instruction (which has now been disallowed without approval of UAC); the earlier decision to remove certain sensitive products from the LOA is upheld.

**5.2. M/s. Srikaram Prescience Private Limited**

5.2.1. Shri R. Ramanathan, Director, Shri A. Ramesh, Director and Shri Sumit Wadhva, Authorised Representative of M/s. Srikaram Prescience Private Limited appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. He requested to the Approval Committee for reconsideration of the products under HS Code 0801, 0802, 0904, 9101, 9111, 91149030, 9608 & 2616.

5.2.2. The Approval Committee discussed the proposal in detail in light of the sensitivity of business plan and Guidelines for Operational Framework of FTWZ & Warehousing units in SEZ issued vide Instruction No. 117 dated 24.09.2024. It was noted that Instruction 117 had specifically come in the light of the adverse reports and inputs received related to functioning of some warehousing units. The





Committee maintained its position that on account of the sensitivity given the investigations including on DTA sales, quality of consignments including the risk of diversion due to the long inland transport, absence of economic rationale after incurring such high freight costs, difficulties in valuation due to volatility of prices, possibility of trading in precious metals, referencing some of the high risk commodities which are part of their LOA in Instruction 117, cases of transfer from other FTWZs prior to this Instruction (which has now been disallowed without approval of UAC); the earlier decision to remove certain sensitive products from the LOA is upheld.
