**Minutes of the meeting of Approval Committee i.r.o. NSEZ held on 29/01/2026****नौएडा विशेष आर्थिक क्षेत्र****(दिनांक 29/01/2026 को आयोजित अनुमोदन समिति की बैठक का कार्यवृत्त)****Minutes of meeting of the Approval Committee of Noida SEZ held under the Chairmanship of Shri Deen Bandhu Singh, Development Commissioner (DC), Noida SEZ at 11:30 AM on 29/01/2026 through hybrid mode.**

A. The following members of the Approval Committee were present during the meeting:-

- (1) Shri Paras Mani Tripathi, Jt. Development Commissioner, NSEZ (Nominee of Deptt. of Commerce in terms of letter dated 23/09/2008).
- (2) Shri Saibal Roy, Asstt. Commissioner, Customs, Noida Commissionerate (Nominee of the Commissioner of Customs, Noida Customs Commissionerate, Gautam Budh Nagar).
- (3) Smt. Alka Mishra, Income Tax Officer, Income Tax Deptt., Noida (Nominee of the Principal Commissioner of Income Tax, Noida).
- (4) Shri Vinay Kumar, Manager, Noida Authority (Nominee of the Chief Executive Officer, New Okhla Industrial Development Authority).

B. Besides, during the meeting S/Shri (i) Kiran Mohan Mohadikar, Dy. Development Commissioner, NSEZ; (ii) Ravikesh Tripathy, Specified Officer, NSEZ; (iii) Amir Eqbal, Asstt. Development Commissioner; (iv) Bharat Bhushan, Assistant, NSEZ; and (vi) Manoj Kumar, Preventive Officer, NSEZ were also present to assist the Approval Committee. It was informed that the stipulated quorum for holding the meeting was available and meeting could proceed.

C. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the participants. After a brief introduction, the agenda were taken up sequentially. After detailed deliberations amongst the members of the Approval Committee as well as interaction with the applicants / representatives of the units, following decisions were unanimously taken:-

**D. Item wise decisions on proposals included in agenda:****(1) Ratification of Minutes of last meeting of the Approval Committee held on 12/01/2026.**

It was informed to the Approval Committee that there were neither any references nor objections against the decisions of the Approval

Committee held on 12/01/2026. Hence, the Approval Committee took note of the same and accordingly, the Minutes of the meeting held on 12/01/2026 were unanimously ratified by the Approval Committee.

**(2) AAC Protec India Private Limited - Change of ITC(HS) Code of existing approved authorized operations.**

2.1 Shri K.N. Srivastava, director of the company appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal. He stated that they were granted LOA in which the code mentioned is 85161000 which is applicable to instantaneous storage water heaters and immersion heaters. Over time, the application of these heaters has evolved and is now exclusively within the semiconductor industry only. These heaters are integral to the production of semiconductor wafers, electronic integrated circuits, and flat-panel displays. Given this exclusive use in the semiconductor sector, they want to reclassify the ITC HS Code as 84869000 & 99030132.

2.2 It was informed that NSEZ Customs has provided their comments in the matter and stated that "Chapter heading 8516 properly and specifically covers the item i.e Electric instantaneous water heaters and the said item is already classified under chapter's subheading 85161000 whereas chapter heading 8486 covers Machines and apparatus of a kind used solely or principally for the manufacture of semiconductor boules or wafers, semiconductor devices. And chapter's subheading 84869000 classifies parts and accessories thereof. As regard, another chapter heading suggested by the unit as 9903, it is noticed that under Indian Customs Tariff Act, chapter 99 is not provided. Therefore, as per the information provided in the aforesaid submission of the unit and keeping in view of the above facts and 'General Rules for the Interpretation of the Harmonized System', it appears that the item manufactured / exported by the unit (i.e. Electric instantaneous water heater) is appropriately / specifically classified under CTH 85161000."

2.3 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, directed to seek a clarification/ guidance from Deptt. of Commerce and DGFT in the matter.

**(3) Bikram Exports - Renewal of LOA and Monitoring of performance.**

**Minutes of the meeting of Approval Committee I.r.o. NSEZ held on 29/01/2026**

3.1 The Approval Committee monitored the performance of unit on the basis of APR submitted upto 2024-25 and noted achievement of positive NFE earnings by the unit. The Approval Committee further observed from the CA certified details of value addition achievement that unit has achieved value addition as per prescribed norms in USD except in 2021-22 (where unit achieved 3.39%).

3.2 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, decided to renew the validity of LOA for remaining period of 4<sup>th</sup> Block of five years i.e. upto 27.05.2030 in terms of Rule 19(6A)(3) of SEZ Rules, 2006. The Approval Committee further directed to examine the matter regarding achievement of value addition by the unit and imposition of penalty, if any, on file.

**(4) C & S Electric Limited - Inclusion of additional authorized operations in LOA.**

4.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal of unit for inclusion of "Manufacturing of: (i) Electrical Insulators (Any Material) (85469090) (50000 Pcs/annum); (ii) Insulator Porcelain (85462090) (25000 Pcs/annum)" as authorized operations in LOA.

**(5) Capgemini Technology Services India Limited - Change in directors.**

5.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, took note of change in director of the company in terms of Instruction No. 109 dated 18/10/2021.

**(6) Garmex (Ind) Apparel LLP - Renewal of LOA and monitoring of performance.**

6.1 Shri Tarsem Sarpal, authorized representative of the unit appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal.

6.2 The Approval Committee monitored the performance of unit on the basis of APR submitted upto 2023-24 and noted achievement of positive NFE earnings by the unit. The Approval Committee observed that after commencement, unit had not made any exports during 2021-22 & 2022-23, however, unit has made exports worth Rs. 495.52 Lakhs and Rs. 56.20 Lakhs during 2024-25 & 2025-26 (upto 04.06.2025).

6.3 The Approval Committee further observed that the unit has been allotted Plot No. 142, NSEZ admeasuring 8100 sq.mtrs. and it had projected exports worth Rs. 12188 Lakhs during first block of five years whereas total exports of Rs. 979.76 Lakhs only have been made during the said period. It shows that the performance of the unit is not commensurate with the previous approved projections & allotted area.

6.4 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, decided to renew the validity of LOA for a period of two years i.e. from 06/06/2025 to 04/06/2027 in terms of Rule 19(6A)(3) of SEZ Rules, 2006. Further renewal of LOA shall be considered on the basis of unit's performance during this extended period.

**(7) Golden Nebhraj Manufacturing Pvt. Ltd. - Setting up a unit in NSEZ.**

7.1 It was informed that M/s. Golden Nebhraj Manufacturing Pvt. Ltd. has submitted an application for setting up a unit in NSEZ for manufacturing of Filter Khaini/ Chewing Tobacco. The Approval Committee observed that Govt. of Uttar Pradesh vide Notification No. 6288/FSDA/FOOD/2012 dated 04/10/2012 has prohibited, in the state of Uttar Pradesh, the manufacture, storage, sale or distribution of Gutkha and Pan Masala containing tobacco or nicotine as ingredients, by whatsoever name it is available in the market. However, applicant has not submitted undertaking in this regard.

7.2 The Approval Committee observed that unsigned copy of Form-F has been given and applicant has also not submitted PAN of both directors and source of funds is not clear. Besides, few other shortcomings have also been observed in the application, which are required to be rectified by the applicant. The Approval Committee also observed that the applicant has also shown Heavy liquid paraffin Oil (27101990) as raw material for the proposed manufactured product, however, its uses are not clarified.

7.3 The Approval Committee, discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, deferred the proposal with a direction to first obtain the reply from applicant on the observed shortcomings in Agenda as well as clarification on the uses of raw material along with an undertaking to the effect that they will comply with the notification of UP Govt. and will not manufacture Gutkha and Pan Masala.

Minutes of the meeting of Approval Committee i.r.o. NSEZ held on 29/01/2026**(8) Mandap International Pvt. Ltd. - Inclusion of additional authorized operations in LOA.**

8.1 Shri Ashvani Madan and Shri Arnav Madan, Directors appeared before the Approval Committee and explained the proposal.

8.2 The Approval Committee observed that the unit has not yet commenced its manufacturing production. Further, the proposed trading item is similar to their manufacturing item.

8.3 The Approval Committee further deliberated in the matter of allowing manufacturing and trading activities in same LOA and observed that Rule 22 of SEZ Rules, 2006 provides that the Unit engaged in both trading and manufacturing activities shall maintain separate records for trading and manufacturing activities. The Approval Committee decided that if any manufacturing unit want to apply for inclusion of trading activities, unit will apply for a separate LOA for trading activities which will ease maintaining separate accounts & records and monitoring of the same thereof.

8.4 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, did not approve the proposal for inclusion of trading of Wheel Rims in the instant LOA and suggested the unit that they may apply for a separate LOA for trading activities.

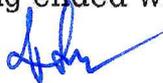
**(9) Indica Industries Pvt. Ltd. - Inclusion of additional ITC(HS) Code for approved item allowed under authorized operations.**

9.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, approved the proposal for inclusion of additional HS Code i.e. 94042990 against Foam Parts.

**(10) Annual Monitoring of Performance in terms of Rule 54 of SEZ Rules, 2006 as per APR received for the year 2024-25.**

10.1 The Approval Committee discussed the agenda in detail and after due deliberations, deferred the proposal with a direction to place the performance of each unit mentioning complete details during block period.
