Minutes of 2nd Meeting (2013 Series) of Unit Approval Committee for EOU Scheme held on 06.08.2013

2nd meeting (2013 Series) of Unit Approval Committee (UAC) for EOU scheme was held on 06.08.2013 at 11.30 AM under the Chairmanship of Shri Jayant Misra, Development Commissioner, NSEZ in the O/o the Development Commissioner, Noida Special Economic Zone, Noida-Dadri Road, Phase-II, Noida. List of participants is enclosed at Annexure-I. The Chairman welcomed all participants of the UAC and thereafter agenda was taken up for discussion.

2.0(13) Confirmation of minutes of 1st meeting (2013 series) of the UAC held on 07.06.2013

The Committee ratified the minutes of the 1st UAC meeting (2013 Series).

2.1(13) Proposal for conversion of existing DTA unit into 100%EOU by M/s Gold Mint India Limited at G-1/34, Gem & Jewellery Zone, EPIP, Sitapura Industrial Area, Jaiur-302022.

The Committee deliberated the proposal and heard the representatives of the unit. The representative of Commissioner of Central Excise raised the issue of input output norms, which are non-existent for present type of proposal. Further, the generation of wastage and manner of its disposal are important issues for the recovery of gold from different types of raw material and has environmental implications. The representative of the unit explained that gold dust, one of the raw material, would yield 40-50% gold and remaining would be a waste comprising of different metals, chemicals and others for which they do not have the recycle facility and would be disposed off in DTA. Considering the proposed production of about 15 tonnes of gold, the waste could be between 15-20 tonnes. It is noted that the Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board has allowed discharge of waste water only and discharge of other waste including solid waste which would arise during recovery of gold needs clarification from them.

Accordingly, pending clarification as discussed above, the Committee decided to defer the proposal.

2.2(13) Proposal for conversion of existing DTA unit into 100%EOU by M/s Ashok & Company- Pan Bahar Limited at 49 A, Rama Road, New Delhi-110015.

The Committee deliberated the proposal and heard the representative of the unit. The Delhi Government vide Notification No. F.1 (3)/DO-I/2012/5185-5203 dated 11.09.2012 issued in pursuance of regulation 2.3.4 of the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restriction of Sales) Regulation, 2011, prohibits manufacture, storage, sale, transportation, display or the distribution of Pan Masala containing Tobacco and/or nicotine as ingredients in the NCT of Delhi.

The Committee noted that the proposal for manufacture of Pan Masala and Pan Masala containing Tobacco is covered by the prohibition of the Delhi Government.

Accordingly, the Committee decided to reject the proposal.

2.3(13) Proposal for Setting up an 100%EOU by M/s Cypress Industries India Pvt. Ltd., Plot No. 12, Udyog Kendra-II, Ecotech-III, Greater Noida, U.P.

The Committee deliberated the proposal and heard the representative of the unit. They informed that investment of Rs. 105 lakhs in the Plant and Machinery has already been done until now. This unit is a wholly owned subsidiary of USA company and the investment in the plant is through FDI. The Committee has taken note of the consent on the proposal from the jurisdictional Central Excise.

Accordingly, the Committee decided to approve the proposal.
